(3) Application requirements

Graduate students and postdoctoral fellows in the Graduate School of Biostudies, Institute for Frontier Life and Medical Sciences, and the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences.

1. Long Talk

We will select participants who have a significant amount of research performance or progress, and who wish to improve their scientific communication skills in English. We also welcome abstract submissions from junior-level students with substantial research accomplishments.

2. Short Talk

We would welcome participants who wish to challenge themselves or to train their English presentation and discussion skills, regardless of their research performance or grade.

3. Poster Presentation

We seek participants who match the application requirements mentioned before.

(4) Evaluations and Commendations

1. Long Talk

Evaluations will be given by invited judges.

2. Short Talk

Evaluations will be given by guest speakers and judges.

3. Poster Presentation

A popular vote will decide the best presentations.

- * All the participants of oral presentation sessions will receive judges' reviews and some feedback pointing out potential improvements to their presentation that might be useful for future presentations.
- * We will provide all participants of the oral presentation sessions with some support programs, such as practicing their presentation. These programs are conducted by Prof. James Hejna, of the Graduate School of Biostudies. (For further details, please refer to the website listed below.)
